The same vision for a new course!

In 1488, the Portuguese navigator Bartolomeu Dias was the first European to reach the southwestern tip of South Africa opening the route to India.

The storms were so violent that he decided to name this place “the Cape of Storms”. King John II of Portugal, hearing the news of this discovery, decided to change this name to “Cape of Good Hope”.

It's the same course, and it's the same storms. The Portuguese navigator called it “the Cape of storms” because he almost lost his life there. But the king chose “Good Hope” because he saw a door opening to his kingdom. The king has changed the course but not the direction.



There are moments in people's lives and in organizations where changes are needed. It's not about changing to change but to better serve our vision. Change may be uncomfortable and raise relevant questions, but it must not lead to conflict with partisans and opponents.

goal is still far away. From South Africa to India, there is still a long way to go, but once past this course, the sailor knew that he had the means to go all the way!

need each other to find our place in the Church. Let us walk on the path that the Lord has prepared for us in advance.


To be “fully in Him” is a state of mind. Keep the focus on the Lord and the service for Him will be easier. Let’s go and bear fruit together, right now!
