“Summer Tour” or “Sower Tour” ?

A special weekend will mobilize the Church from 19 to 21 July 2019. We will welcome a dozen young people for a time of evangelization on the beaches of Arcachon.

A few days ago, by simple play of words, Anthony sent me the picture illustration: «Sower Tour». I laughed seeing it, but very quickly, I realized that it was more than a form of humor, it was a message for the whole Church because that's what it's all about, which one is: to sow.

I thought immediately of the sower of the parable of Jesus: «A sower went out to sow his seed.» Luke 8.5.

The job of the sower is to sow! Obvious isn't it?

But before throwing away its precious substance, there is a whole job of preparation in order to hope to obtain the best possible result. He is preparing his seed, which is the Word of God. Before

sowing it in a heart, it is in the mine that it must be developed. It's because I know how important it is that I will be able to share it. But the sower must also prepare the ground. In summer, the population of the Arcachon



Bay increases from 150,000 to 400,000 people. I pray for all these grounds that the hearts are worked by the Holy Spirit to receive this seed.

Once the sower has done his job, he does not control anything, it is the law of nature that will play its role but no-

thing happens if the sower does not go out to sow his seed!

We can invest ourselves in one way or another during this weekend. Do not let these young people do our job, so at the Summer Tour, let's all sow!
